TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Know Ye, That *Nathan Strong, of Goochland county, Virginia,*
having deposited in the Treasury a certificate of the Register of the land office at *Huntsville,* whereby it appears that
full payment has been made for *the South East quarter of Section four, of Township three, in Range one,*

(East of the basis Meridian)

of the lands directed to be sold at *Huntsville* in pursuance
of the laws providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the Mississippi Territory, ~~There is granted~~, by the United States,
unto the said *Nathan Strong, the quarter* lot or section of land above described: ~~To have and to hold,~~
the said *quarter,* lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said
Nathan Strong, his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made PATENT, and the Seal of the General Land-Office
to be hereunto affixed.
